Coliseum Boulevard Temporary Lane Closure Update:

Traffic Control Barriers to be Installed

During the week of February 22, 2010, a part of the westernmost southbound lanes on Coliseum Boulevard next to the Vista View Shopping Center across from the BP station will again be closed for construction associated with the Coliseum Boulevard Plume-Kilby Ditch project. Traffic control barriers had previously been in place in January but were removed temporarily to allow selection of a new subcontractor who had the specialized equipment required to complete the work.

The lane closure allows the relocation of an existing water line so that the culvert work to cover the West Kilby Ditch can be completed. The water line is being moved so that it will not have to be run underneath the newly constructed culvert.

During this work the southernmost Vista View Shopping Center entrances as well as the back entrance off of Coliseum Parkway will again remain open. On

Coliseum Boulevard one southbound lane will again remain open during the construction and no northbound lanes will be affected.

The lanes closest to the shopping center will be merged to the single southbound lane from the intersection of the Coliseum Boulevard and the Northern Boulevard.

The lanes will be closed for approximately two to three weeks, 24-hours per day, seven days a week. The lanes will be fully reopened when the work is complete.
