Coliseum Boulevard Plume Project Communications

Coliseum Boulevard Temporary Lane Closure

Beginning Monday, January 11, 2010 a part of the westernmost southbound lanes on Coliseum Boulevard (next to the Vista View Shopping Center across from the BP station) will be closed for construction associated with the Coliseum Boulevard Plume- Kilby Ditch project.

The lane closure is to allow the relocation of an existing water line so that the culvert to cover the West Kilby Ditch can be completed. The water line is being moved so that it will not have to be run underneath the newly constructed culvert.

During this work the southernmost Vista View Shopping Center entrances as well as the back entrance off of Coliseum Parkway will remain open. On Coliseum Boulevard one southbound lane will remain open during the construction and no northbound lanes will be affected.

The lanes closest to the shopping center will be merged to the single southbound lane from about 600 feet south of the intersection of the Coliseum Boulevard and the Northern Boulevard.

The lanes will be closed for approximately three to four weeks, 24-hours per day, seven days a week. The lanes will be fully reopened when the work is complete.
