



Coliseum Boulevard Plume Community Outreach Group Monthly Project Update January 2019

The following project activities are planned to take place during the period of **January 1-31, 2019**. In the event that activities are scheduled that were not reflected in this monthly update, an interim update will be issued and posted.

- Groundwater monitoring well be conducted during the month of January. Samples will be collected from 100 monitoring wells.
- Routine surface water samples will be collected as required by the Settlement Agreement for Voluntary Response, effective March 10, 2015 (“the Agreement”) and the approved plans and permits. Quarterly surface water effectiveness samples are collected in January, April, July and October each year. Compliance samples are collected every two weeks.
- Operation of the treatment systems and maintenance (including spraying and mowing and fence upkeep) of the project and treatment areas will continue in accordance with approved plans. Additionally, ALDOT will be repairing some erosion along the concrete-lined ditch south of the fence near Vista View.
- Routine observations and management of the plume area continue.
- **Additional Community Outreach Group members are needed to represent the Chisholm community. - Should you have a project in the Coliseum Boulevard Plume area that involves excavation, drilling or potential contact with groundwater, please contact Adam Anderson or Jeff Laymon at ALDOT’s Bureau of Materials and Tests at 334-271-2200 as you are planning your project. ALDOT subscribes to AL 811 “Call before you dig” service, but can provide information about the plume during planning. Per Alabama law, everyone, including homeowners must contact Alabama 811 at least two working days prior to the start of any excavation project – no matter how large or how small – especially if you are using any type of mechanized equipment. Call 811 or log onto <http://www.al811.com/> to provide required notice before construction that includes excavation or drilling.
